WINERY BACKGROUND

The Bodega Viñedos Cigarral de Santa María, a country house in Toledo, was founded in 1997 by a famous restaurant owner called Adolfo Muñoz who is also president of the Adolfo-Toledo restaurant group. The estate covers an area of seven hectares around the main building where the small bodega or winery and the family home are to be found. Of this area just four are set aside for wine-growing. It is the only urban vineyard in Spain and one of four which exist in the whole world, each to be found in places as magical as Toledo: Malibu, Vienna and Paris.

A black/purple color is accompanied by tantalizing aromas of lead pencil shavings, creme de cassis, pepper, white chocolate, and blackberries. This heady, intoxicating Syrah boasts abundant quantities of flavor as well as body.

Robert Parker's Wine Advocate - Score: 93 (2005 Vintage)

The 2005 Pago del Ama Syrah is a glass-coating opaque purple. Aromas of smoke, creosote, blackberry, and blueberry jump from the glass. This leads to a tight, structured wine in which there is good integration of oak, tannin, and acidity. All this wine needs is 4-6 years of further bottle age.
